

ERX is excited to announce the launch of our new online parking system!

This year everyone will be able to go online, register, and process payment on their own. I will go into explaining how the process will work so everyone is on the same page.

We will be releasing the online system to each row on the following select dates:

**Current First Row holders- Oct 29<sup>th</sup> @ 6:00am**

**Current Second Row holders – Nov 1<sup>st</sup> @ 6:00am**

**Current Upper Lot holders – Nov 4<sup>th</sup> @ 6:00am**

**Open to the public – Nov 7<sup>th</sup> @ 6:00am**

This will allow each row the opportunity to purchase their current parking spots, as we want to be fair in giving you the chance to do so. Each row will be given 3 days to go on and purchase your spot before opening it up to the next wave of riders. The format will be very similar to our old paper form, but instead it is an interactive map for you to purchase your spot from.

Before purchasing your space, double check and make sure that your rig is able to fit in the space you are purchasing. Each spaces dimension will be located on the interactive map. **Please note, you must fit your entire rig in the dimension marked. Only 1 vehicle is allowed in each season parking space (if it can fit along with the rig)**
